Major Degrees of the Order

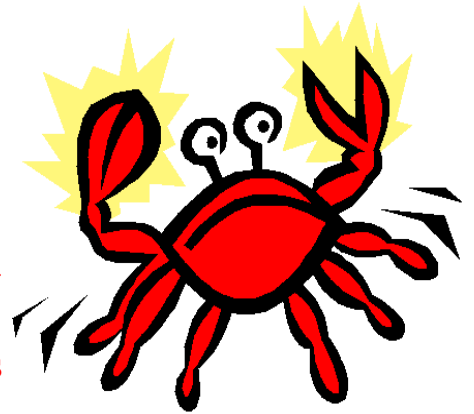
